In an initiative to provide improved minimum standards of building and fire safety for residents, visitors, business owners, and firefighters, Wauconda Fire Protection District administrative officials worked closely with the fire district's Board of Trustees to adopt the district's Fire Prevention Code. In doing so, all new construction buildings (including one- and two-family homes, townhomes and multifamily) within the unincorporated areas of the district must include fire sprinkler protection.



The Wauconda Fire Protection District joins the ranks of more than 110 Illinois jurisdictions that have zero-square-foot requirements for fire sprinklers.

The Wauconda Fire Protection District has made fire sprinklers the front-line defense against fires in order to prevent needless injuries and deaths and greatly reduce property damage from fires.
