### Fire & Life Safety Plan Review\*

- \*Required course for OSFM Certificate
- \* Only required for the Advanced Fire Prevention Officer certificate

#### Prerequisites:

1. Certification as an Inspector or 5 years of documented building or fire inspection experience.
2. Course includes a practicum. The student will have to complete and submit a report on an assigned building project.
3. A certificate of completion will not be discussed until the final exam and the practicum project are submitted and reviewed.

**Required Text:** Locally-enforced Building & Fire Codes with local Amendments and NFPA 101, if applicable.

### Earn Your Illinois OSFM Advanced Fire Prevention Officer Certificate

A six-day interactive class utilizing the Job Performance Requirements (JPR) and course objectives as outlined for plans examiner in NFPA 1031. The class is designed for fire inspectors and anyone meeting the basic requirements and standard criteria.

This interactive course will include identification and examination of the course objectives 1-20 as they correspond to municipal codes, standards, and plan reviews. Opportunities will be present for students to interpret and evaluate code requirements and plans to ensure they are in compliance with fire and safety standards. Additionally, through discussion and reviewing kinetic plan reviews, students will be able to apply scenario-specific construction documentation.

Students will be tasked to analyze and interpret applicable International Building Code© and International Fire Code© sections.


